Maximize Your Benefits and Results:

- Install RootX only after the Spring Thaw, and before the Winter Freeze
 Up. Over the winter, trees become dormant, and your RootX installation will not be as successful.
- 2. Use the Push Rod End at every **RootX** install. You must ensure a full pipe of foam the entire length of the lateral to get maximum results.
- 3. Never install a 4 pound jar of **RootX** in one lift. Always split the jar into 2 2lb lifts, using 5 gallons of water after each 2 pound lift.
- 4. **RootX** is a maintenance item. It is not a cure-all. If you normally cut a line once every year, make sure to go back and do another RootX application on the anniversary date of the original install.
- 5. Camera your lines that have been treated with **RootX** every year to 18 months, applying **RootX** as shown to be required by your video tapes.
- 6. Use the <u>"RootX Has Been Applied"</u> stickers that are provided to you and place them on all water fixtures and appliances. It is critical to a successful RootX application that water is not used for at least 6 hours. You must give the RootX time to bond with the lateral to help impede future root growth.
- 7. Follow the installation techniques and instructions shown on Wallace's tutorial tape. Using the correct steps and equipment will help to ensure a great **RootX** treatment and result.
